CWSL Rules were used to determine CLASS and CONCURRENT winners (when two or more shooters tied, a random drawing picked the winner, see asterisks). Lewis class payouts (4 classes total) were also chosen by random drawing of tied scores. Lewis class purse = \$4 per entry.

CWSL PURSE: \$4/entry x 36 shooters = \$144 total divided into 4 classes = \$36 per class. CWSL pays out two places per class (\$18 per shooter). Extra Hi Gun (\$18) covered for by CWSL by rule (2016).

PURSE: \$5/entry x 17 shooters = \$85 total divided into 5 classes [+3 CHs (\$5x1)] = \$14 per class

SPT&S PAYOUT RULES: Standard Lewis class rules were followed. All event purses (\$5 per entry) are divided evenly between Lewis class winners, with 4 or 5 shooters per class. Champ receives additional \$5. All Champs win a class purse plus \$5. When two shooters tie, class purse is split. When three or more shooters tie, class purse is awarded to the reverse long run winner. With two or more CHs, no Class A is awarded.
